- 2. Minimum 4 years' experience with direct human services case work
- 3. Moderate experience with Microsoft Suite: (Outlook, Word, Excel) and client databases (i.e., CRMs) including HMIS, preferred
- 4. Bachelor's degree in human services or related field, master's degree preferred
- 5. Grant writing/reporting experience, preferred
- 6. Must obtain HUD Housing Counseling Certification within 18 months of hire
- 7. Must have valid PA driver's license and willingness to work weekends on occasion

- Coordinate client referrals with staff capacity, community need and/or funder requirements.
