



Homeowner Mini Grant Program

For emergency repairs and housing maintenance

Qualifications for Assistance

Up to \$3,000 in assistance is available to low to moderate income homeowners in the form of mini grants. Assistance can include emergency repairs or necessary housing maintenance needs.

Applicants must:

- Live in the City of Erie
- Own a single family dwelling no less than a year before application
- Meet U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) income requirements of 80% and below median income
- Provide 2-3 estimates* from local and reputable contractors with the application detailing the work to be performed and the total cost

1 persons	\$40,050
2 persons	\$45,800
3 persons	\$51,500
4 persons	\$57,200
5 persons	\$61,800
6 persons	\$66,400
7 persons	\$70,950
8 persons	\$75,550

To qualify for assistance under the City of Erie Homeowner Mini Grant Program, you must meet these income guidelines established by HUD.

*Effective July 1, 2020. Income limits change annually.
